THINGS TO KNOW

~ PARKING ~

- Parking is \$5 per day or \$10 for the weekend at Starfire Sports
- To avoid the daily or weekend fee, pick up a Starfire Membership, which includes an annual parking pass
- Carpooling is highly encouraged as the main parking lot is expected to be full throughout the weekend
- Any parking pass (daily, weekend, or annual) will get you a spot in either our main lot or our neighboring corporate lots. Due to capacity limitations, parking may only be available in Starfire's neighboring corporate lots for a significant portion of the weekend.
- No recreational vehicles are allowed inside the park
- Parking is not charged at Valley Ridge Park

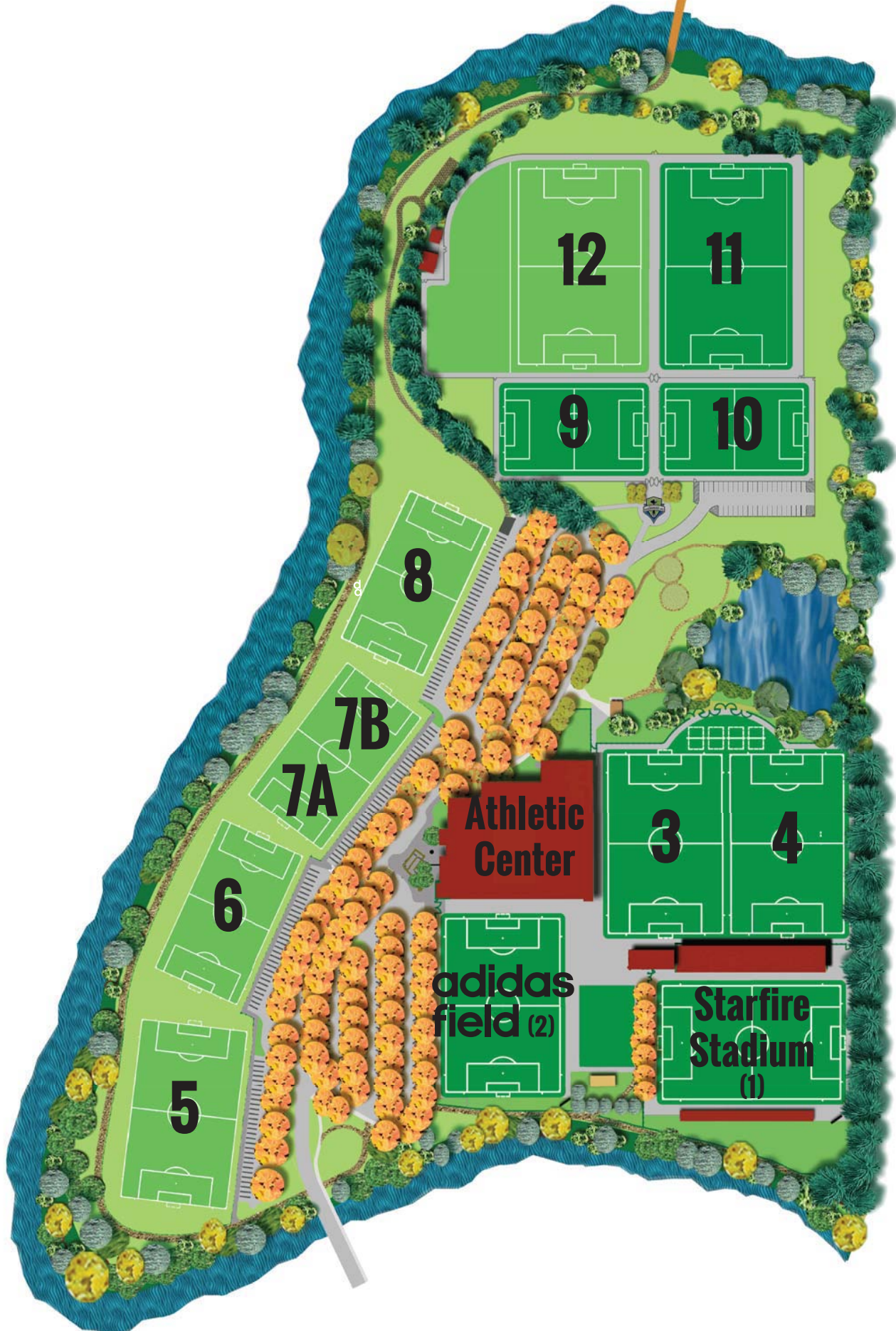
~ CHECK IN ~

- Prior to competing, you must check in with the Tournament Registrar at least an hour before your first match
- A **signed club roster** with jersey numbers & birth dates must be turned in at time of check-in
- Guest players must present identification & proof of age
- Check in will be located in the **Starfire Pavilion** under the white tent next to adidas field 2 & will be open beginning at 11 AM on Friday morning until 10 PM on Friday night. It will then re-open at 6:45 AM on Saturday morning at Starfire & 7:30 AM at Valley Ridge

~ GENERAL INFORMATION ~

- Teams should be at the appropriate field at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled match kickoff
- Coaches & parents are responsible for ensuring sidelines are clean after each game
- Fields 1-4 & 9-11 are turf, 5-8 are grass; Valley Ridge fields are all field turf
- Starfire provides canopies at all fields at Starfire & Valley Ridge. Benches are also available on Starfire fields 1-4 & 9-11. Unfortunately, there are no benches on fields 5-8 or at Valley Ridge. Team benches are encouraged for these fields
- No pets are allowed on the premises
- Food & beverages are available in the tournament village at our full service concessions, satellite concessions in the North campus, or from on-site restaurants in the Athletic Center-Cafe Sienna & Zaw Pizza

STARFIRE CAMPUS MAP

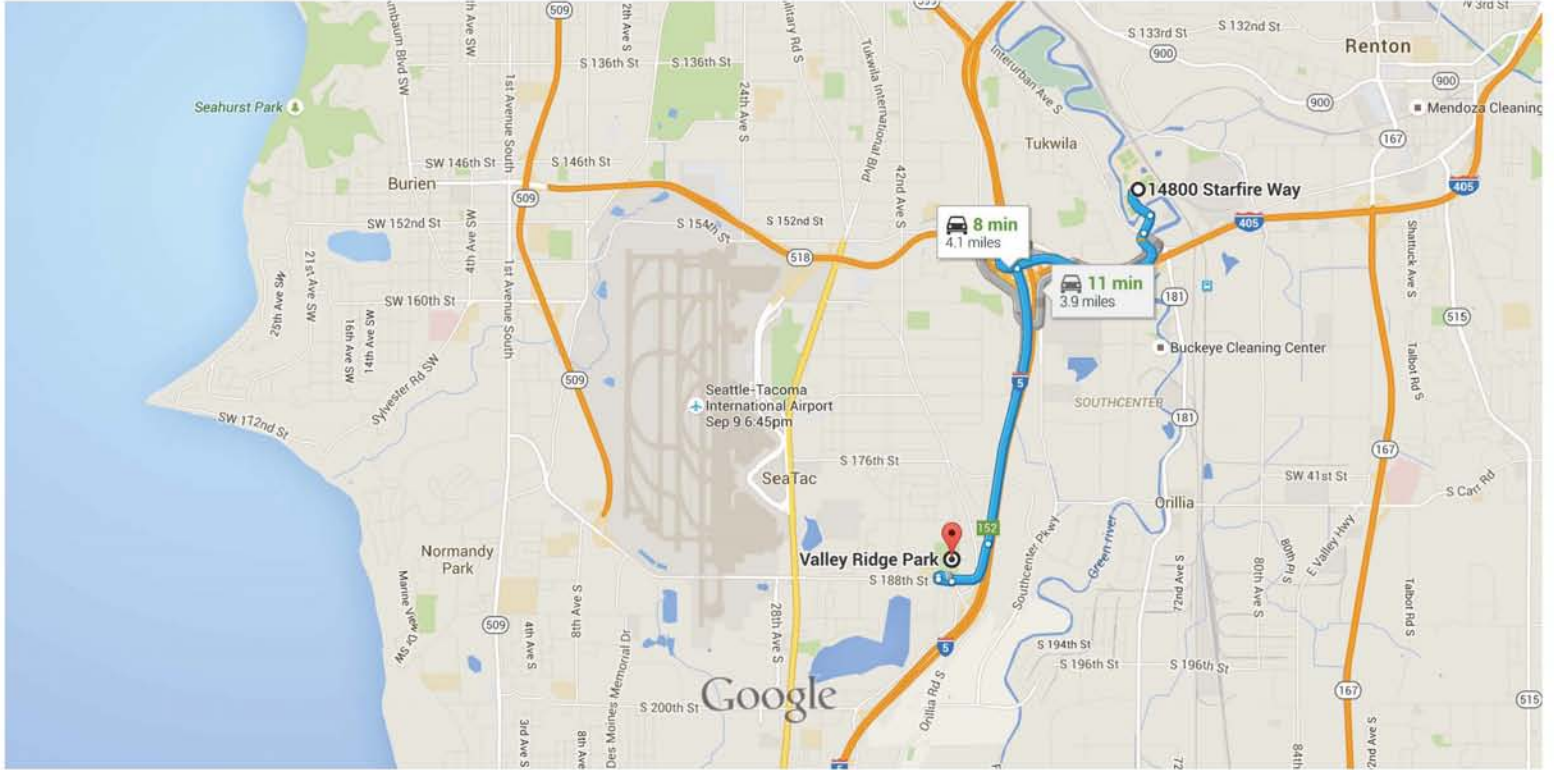

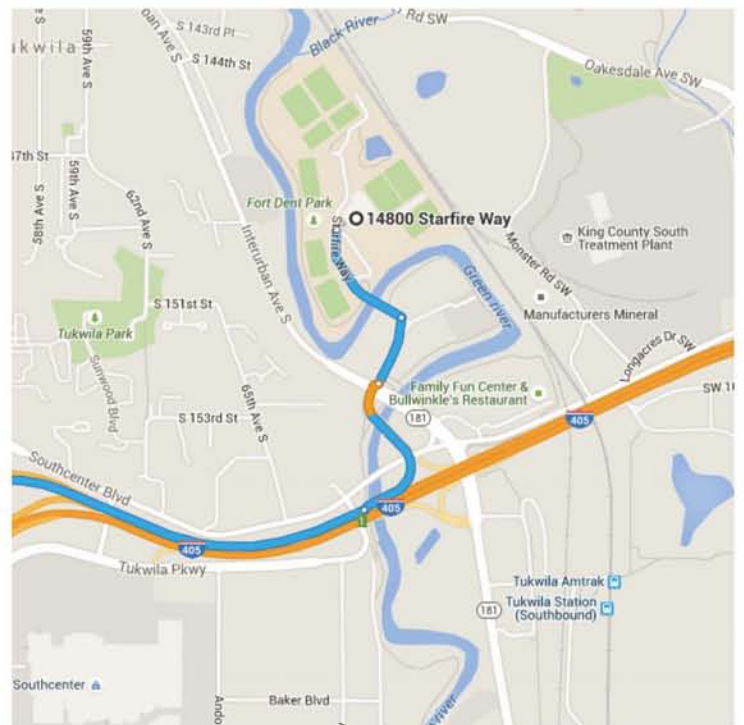

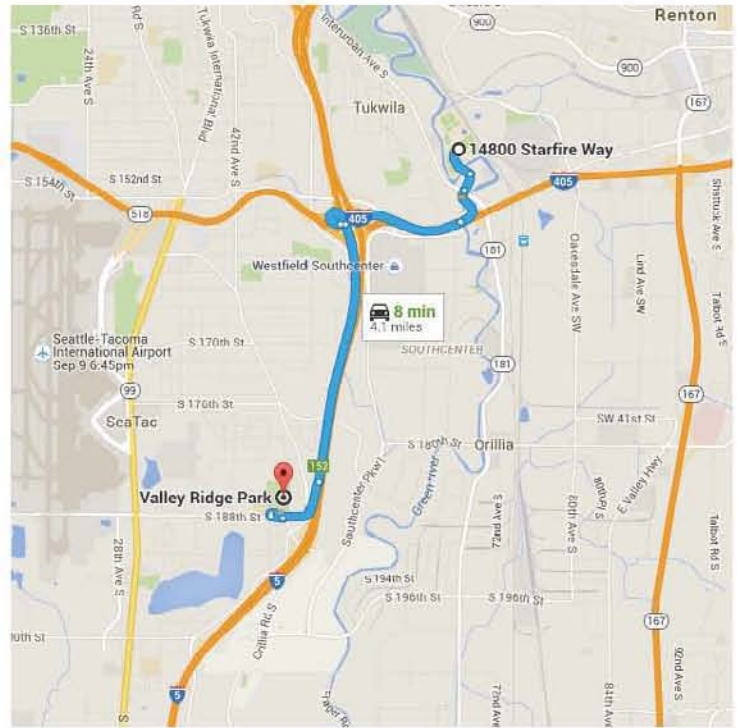


Continue on I-405 S. Take I-5 S to S 188th St in

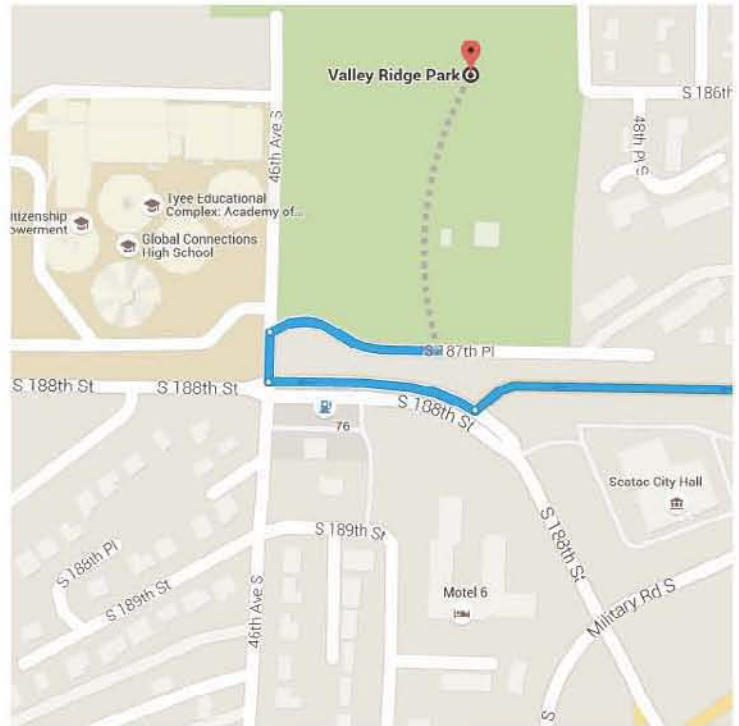

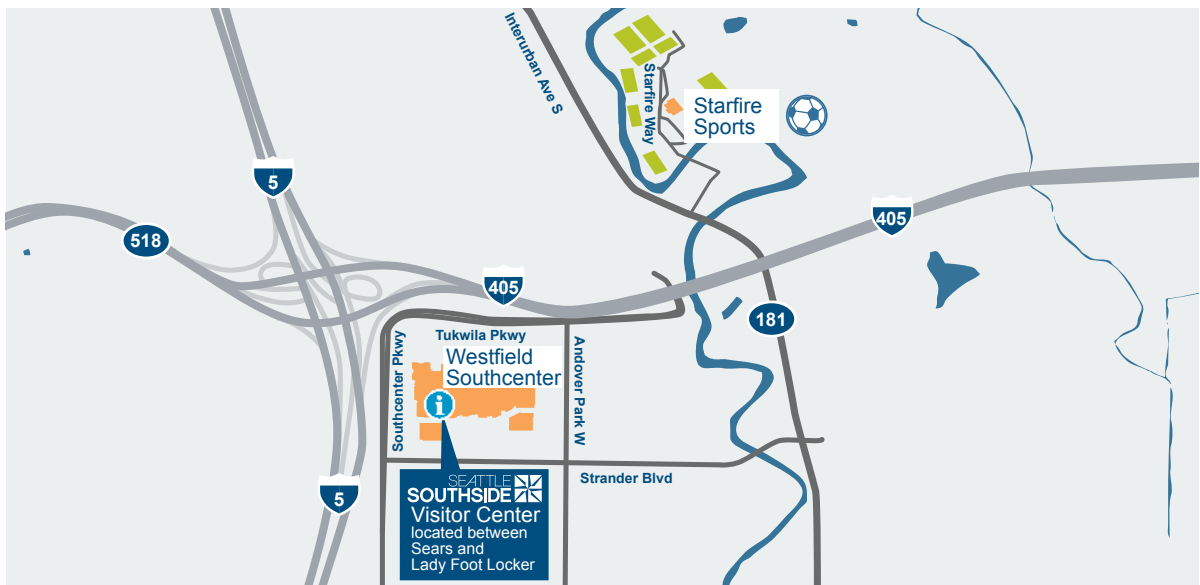

WESTERN CANADA COLLEGE ID CAMP

July 17th-22nd
at Shawnigan Lake School

With the goal to promote youth players into environments which will challenge them academically and athletically after high school, EPIC and the Vancouver Whitecaps have partnered in this unique experience which we believe will connect players who are in grade 12 or who are going into grades 9-12, with college coaches from all levels in Canada and the USA.

What Makes us Unique?

College / University coaches will run the training sessions and observe the players in the evening games. Each day players will receive informational, motivational, and college specific information from the staff and the college / university coaches where collegiate association rules allow. Coaches of Canadian schools will be provided brief Q&A periods within the daily schedule. NCAA coaches will join in on a panel discussion and discuss such topics as registering with the eligibility centre, NCAA academic standards, NCAA recruiting legislation, admissions standards, and recruiting timeline.

What is Included in the Camp?

Players will stay at Shawnigan Lake School for the duration of the camp. During that time they will be under the supervision of the camp staff. Players will stay in the dorms and will eat at the beautiful Shawnigan Lake School.

Players train once per day and play in games once per day as our goal is to showcase a rested and ready athlete to the college coaches in attendance. This camp is about QUALITY versus QUANTITY. Players will have their profile (names, addresses, contact information) included within the 'Player Profile Book' that will be distributed to the college coaches in attendance (a form will be sent to you which will collect necessary information for this profile).
